WAHA International is an International NGO founded in 2009, whose mission is to improve access to health services and the quality of healthcare in disadvantaged communities and to disadvantaged populations such as refugees and IDPs. Since the outbreak of the current refugee crisis in Europe and the Middle East, WAHA has been present in all key locations in order to provide health services through rescues, screening, primary healthcare, psychological support and referrals to those in need through the use of mobile, semi-fixed and fixed clinics.

In Greece, WAHA began its project in September 2015, covering key locations in Athens, the North and various first-reception islands. Key partners in WAHA's operations have included UNHCR, the Greek Ministry of Health, the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the European Commission's Humanitarian Aid and Civil Protection department (ECHO) through its partnership with Arbeiter-Samariter-Bund (ASB). WAHA has conducted over 50,000 medical consultations since the start of its activities in Greece.

MISSION AND PRINCIPAL ACTIVITIES

1. Main Duties:

- He/she will conduct medical examination and medical diagnosis and treatment for children and adolescents under the Greek law.
- He/she will keep records of the appropriate vaccinations given to the children under the Greek law.
- He/she will keep records in medical examinations for all the new-born children.
- He/she will advise and give awareness on prevention and hygiene control for children epidemics.

2. Other duties

- Strengthening the WAHA identity, values and principles by reflecting, discussing and contributing to the advocacy mandate
- Ensuring an oral handover at every team changeover, drawing attention to any notable events during the shift
- Following WAHA's guideline on visibility activities
- Following any other instructions relevant to the mission from the Field Coordinator

- Previous working experience as a paediatrician required
- Licence to work as a paediatrician in Greece is mandatory
- Proficiency in English is required
- Language skills in Greek and Arabic are highly appreciated
